











There are honestly so many options! *Collect memories, not things.*

There are so many items in our **everyday life** that we can switch to being more sustainable! Phone cases, speakers, bottles of water, flasks, bags and towels!


You can also find the work of so many small **businesses** on <u>Etsy</u>, as well as so many unique <u>sustainable gifts!</u>

Sustainable decorations


There are so many places that offer this nowadays. After the Christmas period, they then pick it up, **replant it** on their farm and get it all ready for the next year!



BUY A TREE SECOND-HAND OR REUSE



Another option is to buy an artificial tree second-hand (at least we are giving one another life) or simply keep using yours until it's no longer usable, not just until you get bored of it. When it does come to the end of its life, dispose of it correctly.





USE LED LIGHTS

Just imagine how much **energy** is used to power all these Christmas lights!

- Switch to **energy-efficient LED lights** which use 80% less energy;
- -Use **solar-powered lights** for the outdoors;

USE NATURE & GET CREATIVE

SOY OR BEESWAX CANDLES

"Normal" candles are usually made with **paraffin wax**, which is a byproduct of petroleum refining. When burned, it releases toxic chemicals into the air. Stick with **natural ingredients** instead!

PLANTABLE CARDS

It can be very fun to buy **sustainable paper** and make your own or buy <u>plantable cards</u>! When the person is done with it, it can be put into a **pot and grow** into something.



Sustainable wrapping

CLOTH WRAPPING

Reuse cloths or pieces of textiles and make your **wrapping unique**.



BROWN AND/OR RECYCLED PAPER



Make it **sustainable & unique**. Decorate & draw at your own liking. No need for a card either, write your message on the wrapping & use **twine or rope** as a ribbon!


REUSE OLD PAPER AND KEEP MORE

The "normal" wrapping paper isn't good!

Scrunch test: to see if it is recyclable scrunch up the wrapping paper, if it remains scrunched it can be recycled. If it unfolds itself it has to go to **landfill**.



Therefore, **REUSE** your wrapping paper as much as possible!

BUY LOCAL & IN-SEASON

By doing so, you are supporting local businesses and your food will have a much **lower carbon footprint** (since less transportation is needed).





TRY PLANT-BASED DISHES

People think of vegan/vegetarian food as **boring**. So untrue! So many delicious things can be made, just do a little

research! I love taking inspiration from Veganbowls and Deliciously Ella.


TRY ORGANIC/VEGAN DRINKS


